More of her yokai and monster drawings appear in *Ketsueki* (Markosia, 2011) and *Tam O'Shanter* (Cranachan, 2019).

James Pearson is the Reuters Bureau Chief in Hanoi. He holds a BA in Chinese and Korean from the University of London's School of Oriental and African Studies and an M.Phil in Oriental Studies from the University of Cambridge.

Andray Abrahamian is the 2018–19 Korea Fellow at the Asia-Pacific Research Center, Stanford University and is a member of the US National Committee on North Korea.


