Genshitsu Sen has served as an advisor to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as a UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador and president of the U.N. Association of Japan. He has advanced the idea of "Peacefulness through a Bowl of Tea" and has traveled the world to spread the culture of *Chado*.

Sōseki Natsume (1867-1916) is considered by Japanese readers to be the most significant modern Japanese writer. He was sent to London for three years by the Japanese government in 1900 on the first English literary scholarship, where he developed a love for Shakespeare and Dickens. Returning to take up a position at Tokyo University, Sōseki began his writing career with the novel *Botchan*.




