Hidden Japan

An Astonishing World of Thatched Villages, Ancient Shrines and Primeval Forests

By Alex Kerr

Originally published in Japanese as a call to preserve disappearing facets of Japan’s rich and ancient culture, this book takes its inspiration from the 1960s classic, *Hidden Hamlets* by Shirasu Masako. Like Shirasu, Kerr travels to remote and lesser-known places around Japan where pockets of traditional culture can still be found. Some are faraway—like Aogashima Island, 200 miles south of Tokyo—while others are

easy to reach, such as Mii-dera temple just east of Kyoto. The engaging essays in this book describe surprising remnants of Japan’s fragile physical and cultural environment including:

- **An austere but delicious kaiseki meal in Tottori composed of local herbs and meats**
- **Avant-garde Butoh dancers in the remote village of Tashiro in Akita Prefecture**
- **How shochu liquor is distilled from tropical ferns on the Pacific island of Aogashima**

Kerr includes many anecdotes relating to his childhood growing up in Japan and his passion for restoring old houses, and discusses the damage caused by governmental infrastructure policies as well as tourism. His sharp eye for detail and exquisite descriptions of Japanese arts, architecture and foods will inspire readers who already appreciate his unique look at the “reality” of Japan beyond the romance.

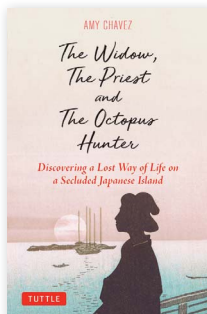

with her to America just before her Shifu passed. He told her that her imbalance would one day kill her. But of course she never listened.

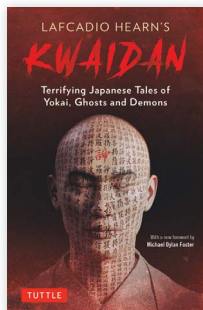
Whenever Tigress has the chance, she will jump into the cage again and fight. Usually the big men have no idea what is coming at them. Until it is too late!

Shu Qingchun became famous as the Beijing novelist and dramatist Lao She whose best-known work is *Rickshaw Boy*. He was killed, or committed suicide, during the Cultural Revolution.

Robert Hegel is a specialist in Chinese literature and the former Liselotte Dieckmann Professor of Comparative Literature and professor of Chinese Washington at University in St. Louis, Missouri.

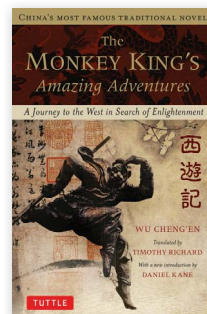

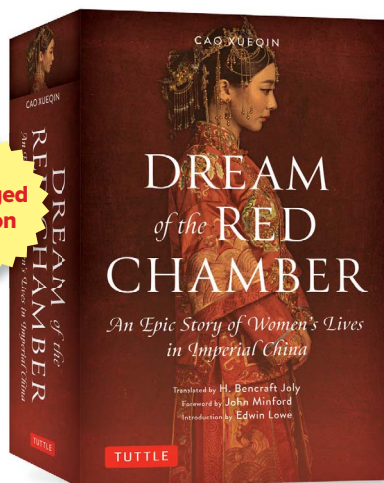

Dream of the Red Chamber is renowned for its epic scope, rich psychological characterizations and telling observations on family life and the role of women in Chinese society. It is widely regarded as the greatest Chinese classical novel and one of the greatest works of world literature ever written.

The “Red Chamber” refers to a sheltered area in wealthy households where daughters were confined until married—a veritable prison where dreams of true love wither. This sweeping tale tells of two star-crossed lovers from rival branches of the wealthy Jia family, who live in lavish adjacent compounds surrounded by a private garden. The fates of the lovers and their families slowly unravel as this tragic tale unfolds.

Although written by a man, *Dream of the Red Chamber* is said to be one of the first great works of women's literature. The author, Cao Xueqin, is thought to have written the novel as a memorial to the inspiring women he knew in his youth, and the book is filled with strong female characters who struggle against the restrictions of a blatantly misogynistic society.

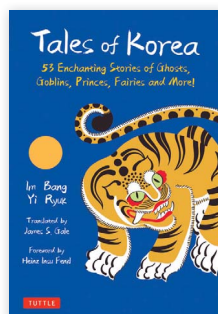
Cao Xueqin was born into a wealthy family whose status diminished and whose fortune was confiscated when he was still a child; spending the remainder of his life in poverty. He wrote *Dream of the Red Chamber* over a period of twenty years.

H. Bencraft Joly was Vice-Consulate of Macao at the time he translated *Dream of the Red Chamber* in an effort to advance an appreciation of Chinese literature among Westerners.

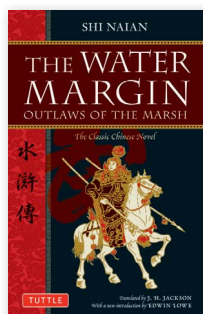
John Minford has published widely on Chinese literature and translated numerous works including *Strange Tales from a Chinese Studio* and the *Art of War*.

Sugimoto went on to publish several novels and moved to New York City, where she taught Japanese language and history at Columbia University.

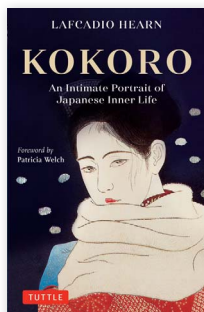

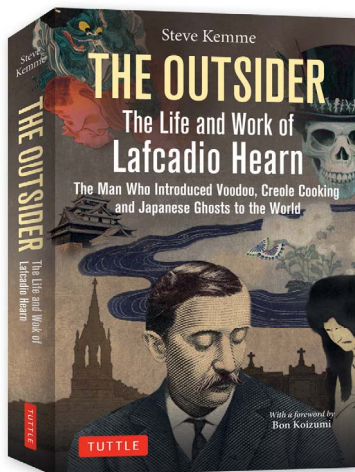

The Man Who Introduced Voodoo, Creole Cooking and Japanese Ghosts to the World

Born in Greece and abandoned as a child, Lafcadio Hearn lived the life of an exile. He traveled the world and became a famous writer but always felt like an outsider—in Dublin, London, Cincinnati, New Orleans and French-speaking Martinique. To him, none of these places felt like home.

Hearn’s life in America was punctuated by a string of successes and failures. In Cincinnati he became the city’s best-known crime reporter but was fired after marrying a black woman. Devastated, he moved to New Orleans where he championed French Creole and Caribbean culture in pieces for *Harper’s* and *Scribners*—and created a new image for the city as a place of voodoo and debauchery (the image of New Orleans which many Americans still hold today!).

Hearn arrived in Japan at a time of historic change. Sent there as a correspondent for *Harper’s*, his commission was soon terminated over a dispute. Alone and jobless, he settled in the remote town of Matsue, firmly believing that Japan would provide him with an endless supply of rich writing material—perhaps enough to last a lifetime. And he was right.

Over the next dozen years, Hearn published fifteen books which were lauded by the likes of Mark Twain, William Butler Yeats, Albert Einstein and Charlie Chaplin. Hearn’s books on Japan established his reputation as the leading Western writer on that country—a position he still occupies today.

This book recounts the many colorful episodes in Hearn’s life including:

- His troubled childhood in Ireland and emigration to America with no job or money
- His career as a popular newspaper writer and essayist in Cincinnati and New Orleans, where he found great success but was never fully accepted
- His journey to Japan where he became a Buddhist, married the daughter of a Samurai, took a Japanese name and is now considered one of Japan’s leading writers
- Hearn’s growing fame as a writer, especially for his essays and books on ghosts, demons, monsters and the supernatural realm of Japanese folklore

This book includes a foreword by Bon Koizumi, Hearn’s great-grandson and director of the Lafcadio Hearn Memorial Museum in Matsue, Japan, along with family images which portray the pivotal people and places in Hearn’s extraordinary life.

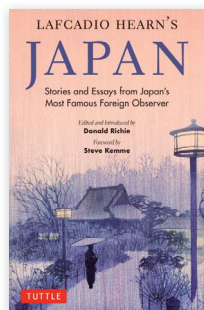
Steve Kemme is President of the Lafcadio Hearn Society/USA and a former reporter for the *Cincinnati Enquirer*, where Hearn formerly worked. He is a member of the Japan Research Center of Greater Cincinnati, has spoken at Hearn symposiums worldwide and is considered a leading expert on Hearn’s life and writings.

Bon Koizumi is Lafcadio Hearn’s great-grandson. He is a professor at the University of Shimane Junior College and director of the Lafcadio Hearn Memorial Museum in Matsue, which is housed in Hearn’s first home in Japan.

Grandmothers, Our Grandmothers underscores the enduring hope of these women that the Japanese government will finally recognize the deep scars their enslavement left on their lives, their families and on humanity as a whole. Because without such recognition, there can be no change. And because crimes against any part of humanity are a crime against all humanity. This book is a warm and loving tribute to the Grandmothers and a call to all of us to stand up for the basic rights of others.

Han Seong-won has been writing and drawing books and articles about modern Korean history for over twenty years. A documentary project on women and war led him to explore the "comfort women" problem, a still fresh example of the long trauma of war. During this journey, through collections of written accounts and participation in the Wednesday Protests, he had the opportunity to speak with surviving Grandmothers who experienced this still unresolved, ignominious moment in human history. This book is his gift to the Grandmothers and to all victims of human rights violations.

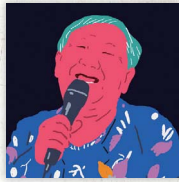

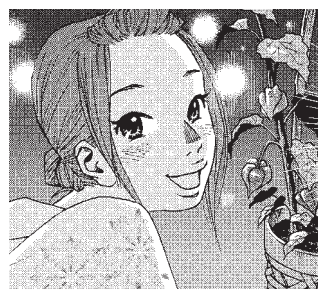
Osamu Dazai

Osamu Dazai is one of Japan's most popular writers, and his works are seeing a huge surge in popularity among young people now thanks to the success of the recent manga, anime and film series *Bungo Stray Dogs*, whose protagonist—a detective named Osamu Dazai—has similar character traits to Yozo Oba. Fans of manga and anime are turning to the original *No Longer Human* novel, whose themes of alienation from society and an inability to reconcile social appearances with inner self—told with great wit, irony and pathos—strike a deep chord among young readers today.

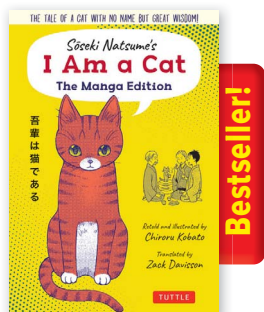
Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) was the pen name of Shuji Tsushima, the tenth of eleven children born to a wealthy landowner and politician in the far north of Japan. Dazai studied French literature at the University of Tokyo, but never received a degree. He first attracted attention in 1933 when magazines began to publish his work. Between 1930 and 1937, he made three suicide attempts, a subject he deals with in many of his short stories. Despite his troubled life and rebellious spirit, Dazai wrote in a simple and colloquial style, conveying his personal thoughts and torments through his writings. Dazai's life ended early in a double suicide with a married lover.

Chika Itoh was born in Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan, and has created many manga, including *Manga Carmilla Girls Only* and *Keita's Oboko Diary*. This is her first publication in English.

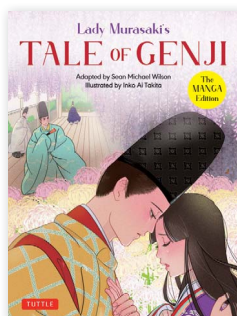

Feline Fishers, Insect Catchers and Art Critics

Cats' priorities, of course, are not always aligned with those of people. The hunting instincts that have made them valuable to humans are also turned against smaller animals, proving disastrous for biodiversity in many parts of the world. In more innocent times, artists created light-hearted genre scenes of curious cats stalking spiders, dipping paws into fishbowl, and pouncing on hapless frogs.

The two prints of cats attacking painted images of butterflies and chickens offer intriguing variations on this theme. Kuniyoshi's design depicts a young woman, the daughter (ca. 1006–1021) of the courtier and renowned calligrapher Fujiwara no Yūkinari (972–1027), seated at her desk. The unnamed daughter was herself an accomplished calligrapher. According to the inscription, Yūkinari's daughter drew butterflies that were so lifelike that her cat, which had hitherto been seated quietly in her lap, suddenly launched itself at them, upsetting her brush pot and tearing the paper. This apocryphal anecdote was perhaps inspired by an episode recorded in *Sarashina Diary*. The author, who had been given a copybook of Yūkinari's daughter's handwriting to use as a model, became convinced that a lost cat that she and her sister adopted (or perhaps catnapped) was the reincarnation of Yūkinari's daughter, who had recently died of smallpox.

The scene of cat the butterflies recalls the fabled

competition between rival artists Zeuxis and Parrhasius described in Pliny's *Natural History*, written in the first century C.E. Zeuxis painted a picture of grapes that was so realistic that birds flew up to peck at it. Parrhasius responded with a painting of a curtain so convincing that Zeuxis requested it to be pulled back so he could view his rival's challenge, and was thus beaten at his own game. While we cannot be sure that Kuniyoshi was familiar with Pliny's story, Kiyochika, working almost half a century later,

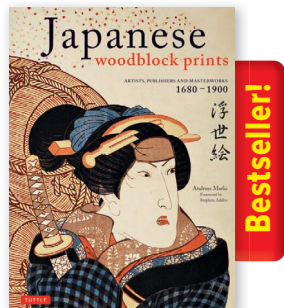

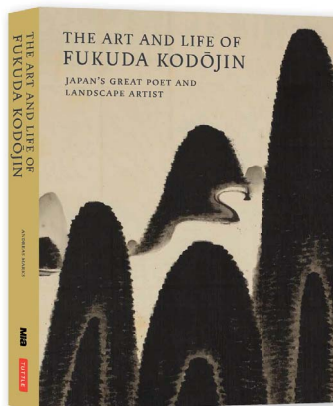

It is generally believed that the tradition of Japanese literati painting (*nanga*) and poetry ended in the mid-nineteenth century. But the great artist Kodōjin was active until much later—right up to the end of his life in 1944.

Kodōjin's painting style is characterized by bizarre mountain forms rendered in vivid colors or stark black, often with a solitary scholar enjoying an expansive view. Not only a painter, Kodōjin was an accomplished poet and calligrapher who received patronage from the leading figures of his era. Following his death, Kodōjin slipped into obscurity but today is receiving renewed attention outside his native Japan. This fully illustrated publication draws from institutions and private collections worldwide, and is the result of many years of intensive research.

Fukuda Kodōjin (1865–1944) was a versatile artist who created over 700 paintings. His work was favored by wealthy patrons who came together to establish the “Kodōjin Society.” Largely forgotten after World War II, today he is highly appreciated outside of Japan. This book is published to accompany a special exhibition of his work at the Minneapolis Institute of Art.

Dr. Andreas Marks is the Mary Griggs Burke Curator of Japanese and Korean Art and Director of the Clark Center for Japanese Art at the Minneapolis Institute of Art. From 2008 to 2013 he was the Director and Chief Curator of the Clark Center for Japanese Art and Culture in California. He has a Ph.D. from Leiden University and a master's degree from the University of Bonn. A specialist in Japanese woodblock prints, he is the author of over eighteen books. In 2014, he received the International Ukiyo-e Society Award in recognition of his research and publications, and in 2018 and 2022 a book award from the International Fine Print Dealers Association.

Paul Berry, an independent scholar of Japanese art history and cinema, has taught at University of Michigan, University of Washington, Kansai Gaidai University and lectured internationally at a number of universities, museums and conferences. His publications include catalogues and articles on Japanese painting. Soon to appear in a volume of essays on Tomioka Tessai and Ōtagaki Rengetsu is “Reinventing Oneself: The Artistic Careers of Ōtagaki Rengetsu” from the National Museum of Asian Art in Washington.

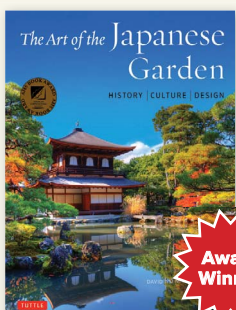

Easy Rice Bran Pickles (Nukazuke)

This is a great introduction to fermentation! You don't have to mix it every day, just keep it in the refrigerator on warm days or when you're busy. Why don't you put in vegetables of your choice and start pickling at your leisure?

4½ cups (500 g) fresh rice bran, or lightly moistened dry rice bran
2 cups plus 2 tablespoons (500 ml) water
2 tablespoons (25 g) salt
2 to 3 small potatoes
1 to 1500 g) vegetables of your choice

Instructions

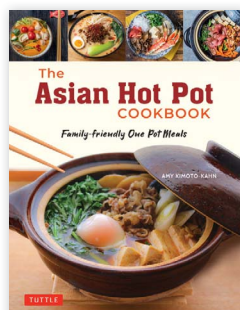
- Put the fresh rice bran and salt in a bowl and mix.
- Make a well in the middle of the rice bran, pour in the water and mix well.
- Transfer to a preserving container, and start by pickling the potato and thickly sliced potatoes. (This makes the pickling bed ferment well.)
- After one day, take the potatoes out, lightly squeeze their juice into the pickling bed, and mix up the pickling bed.
- Wash the vegetables of your choice with a little salt, then squeeze out their excess moisture.
- Smooth out the surface of the pickling bed, push in the vegetables and cover with more of the pickling bed. Pickle the vegetables for half a day to a whole day.

NOTES

- Avoid putting onions or garlic in the pickling bed until the fermentation process is complete. When water comes out of the bed, dispose the bed and let the water drain out by submerging a small cup or other object in it.
- The potatoes, taken out at Step 4, are delicious if they are soaked in water for a bit, pyrolyzed, and stir-fried with garlic.
- If more rice bran needs to be added, add ½ of the amount of existing bran and salt, mix well, and let sit for a few days.
- If you need to reduce the pickling bed, use the extra in the recipe on page 91, Macaroni Cooked in Fermented Rice Bran!

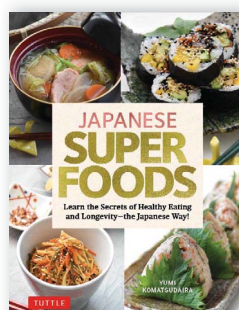

For 20 wontons
20 hulled strawberries
20 egg wonton wrappers (3.5 in/9 cm in diameter)
Vegetable oil, for frying

For the soy purée
½ lb (120 g) shelled yellow mung beans
½ cup (140 g) shredded coconut
½ cup (100 g) baker's sugar
A pinch salt

1 Prepare the soy purée by following the recipe page 132.

2 Set one teaspoon of soy purée in the center of a wonton wrapper. Garnish with a strawberry. Wet the 4 edges of the wrapper and close down the wonton by pulling the corners to the center, just above the strawberry.

3 Heat oil in a deep pan. Check the oil is hot enough by dipping the tip of wonton, chopstick in the oil; you must see bubbles forming. Then dip the wontons in several batches. Let them fry for a few minutes. Flip them over and cook for an additional minute. Drain the wontons when they're light gold.

4 Enjoy hot or warm.

The Shibori Tie-Dye Method



01

This project involves dyeing a white cotton shirt. Make sure to prewash the shirt to remove any fabric softener or other chemical treatments.



02

Start by folding the left sleeve. Create Byōbu-ori folds that are parallel to the length of the sleeve, then tie a knot in the center of the sleeve. Repeat for the right shoulder section.



03



For the right side of the bodice, start the Byōbu-ori folds at a 45-degree angle on the lower half.



04

While holding the folds created in step 3, continue forming the folds toward the top of the bodice.



05

Once the folds have been extended to the bottom placket and side seam, tie a knot at the center section of the folded length.



06

Fold the left shoulder area as well. Because the surface area is less here, make smaller folds.



07

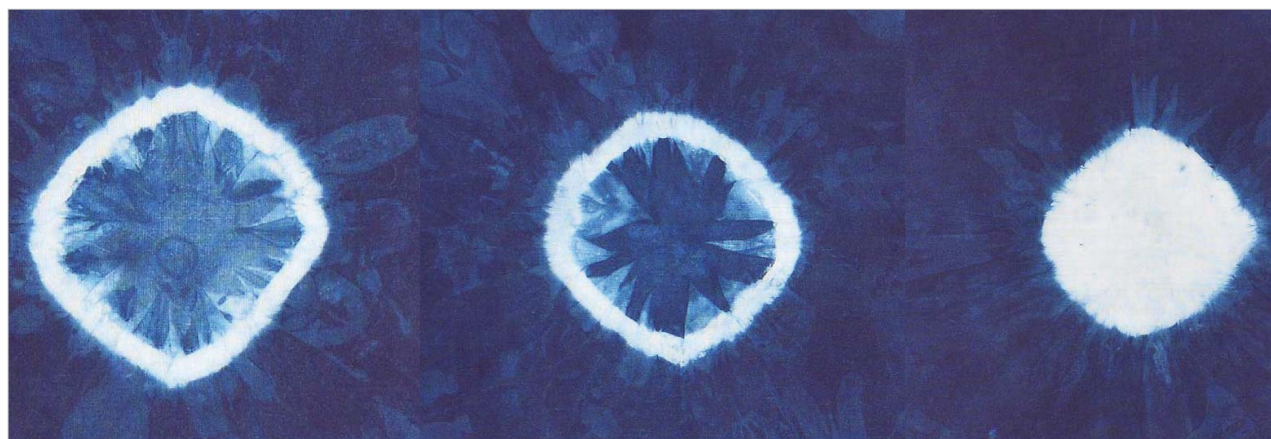
Tie a knot. Because of the folded layers and shorter length, it may be slightly more difficult to form the knot.



Complete

Here is the indigo-dyed and completed shirt. The key to creating crisp shibori patterns is to thoroughly massage the dye into the fabric in the indigo dye vat.

Super Potato Design presents the work of internationally-renowned Japanese designer Takashi Sugimoto. After studying metal sculpture at Tokyo University of Fine Arts, Sugimoto began his career designing a series of bars and restaurants including the iconic Radio Bar in Tokyo that became a favorite hangout for designers like Issey

Miyake, Yohji Yamamoto and Tadao Ando. He was soon recruited to design retail spaces including the original Muji “no-brand” shops along with tea ceremony spaces and wedding chapels.

Super Potato’s striking interiors have revolutionized Japanese design through the use of exposed concrete surfaces, rough-hewn timber and unevenly cut stone juxtaposed with salvaged and repurposed objects to create a sense of power and timelessness. The design vocabulary created by Sugimoto is universally imitated today (in Japan and throughout the world). It is what we now think of as “modern Japanese design”—although Sugimoto’s own work has never been surpassed.

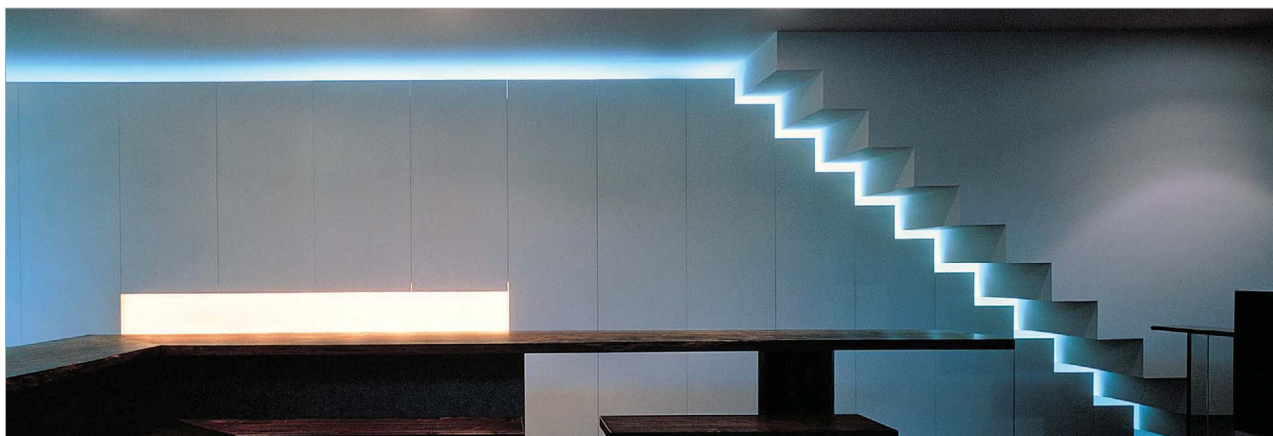
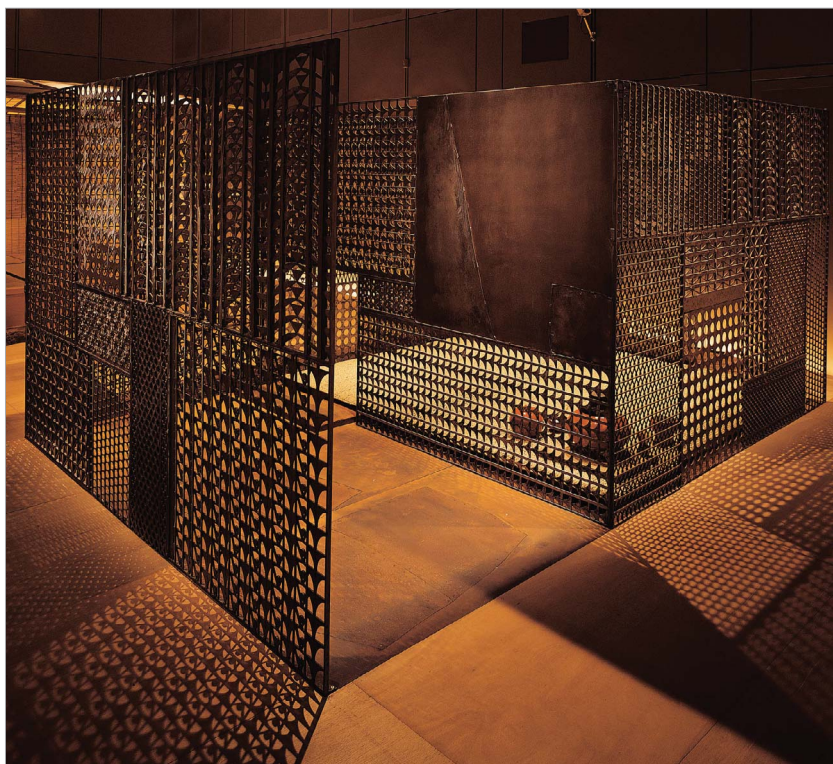

He received the Mainichi Design Award in 1985 and 1986, as well as the Interior Design Association Award in 1992, where he became a Hall of Fame inductee in 2008.

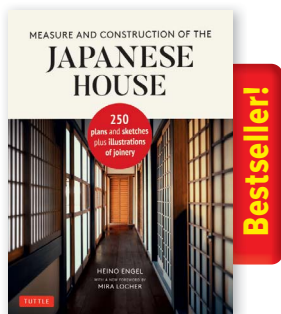
Mira Locher is an architect and educator who works in the US, Canada and Japan. She studied at Smith College before receiving her Master of Architecture degree from the University of Pennsylvania. After working for Team Zoo Atelier Mobile in Japan, she set up an architectural practice in the US with Takayuki Murakami. Locher is now dean of the Faculty of Architecture at the University of Manitoba and the author of many books including *Japanese Architecture*, *Zen Gardens* and *Zen Garden Design*.

Tadao Ando is one of the world’s leading architects and winner of the 1995 Pritzker Prize. As a young man, Ando worked as a boxer then decided to become an architect after being inspired by the work of Frank Lloyd Wright, Le Corbusier and Louis Kahn. Entirely self-taught, he established Tadao Ando Architects & Associates in 1968.

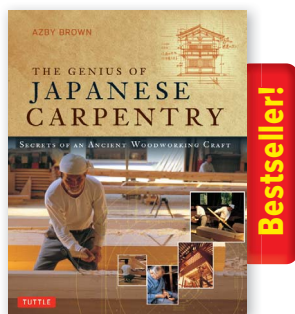
