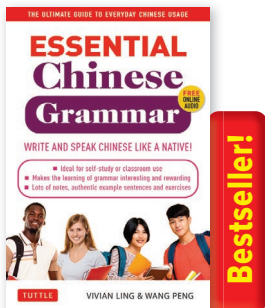
The twelve chapters in this book cover all the essential sentence constructions of Vietnamese—from beginning to advanced level. Strong emphasis is placed on the difference between translating directly from English, which yields awkward and incorrect sentences, and the use of idiomatic Vietnamese constructions and expressions. This book is suitable for self-study or for classroom instruction and is perfect for review and brushing up your language skills.

All Vietnamese grammatical patterns are clearly explained and illustrated through examples. The chapters progress from fundamental concepts (the sounds of Vietnamese, spelling, the use of accent marks and tones) to structural elements (parts of speech, grammatical functions, the structure of phrases and sentences), then to nuances expressed through word choice, word order and cultural elements.

Each chapter is accompanied by extensive exercises (with answer keys provided) that the learner can use to reinforce their understanding of the materials and their ability to apply them to real-life situations. Audio recordings by native speakers are available online for all the Vietnamese sentences to help the learner acquire good pronunciation and intonation patterns for various types of sentences.

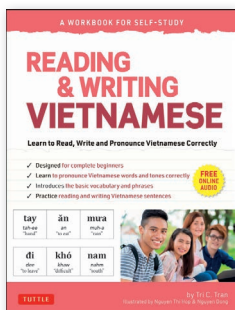

- **The Yamamba Witch's Daughter**—Who would ever dream of marrying a mountain witch? Can the Yamamba's daughter find the love and happiness she seeks?

These stories have been passed down from grandparents to their grandchildren for generations. Well-known throughout Japan, many are believed to have actually occurred in the distant past!

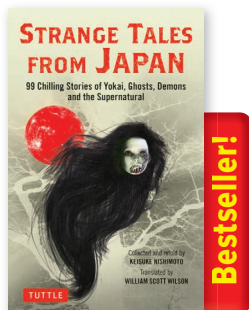
Noboru Wada worked as a school teacher and in 1977 received the first Kenjiro Tsukahara Literary Award for his work *The Fortress of Sorrow*. In 2005, he won the Sankei Award for his book *Weapons Can't Save the Earth*. In addition to anti-war and anti-discrimination children's books, he has written biographies, ghost stories and science fiction for children. *The Snow Woman and Other Yokai Stories from Japan* is his first work to be published in English.

William Scott Wilson has written over 20 books that have been translated into 21 languages. He was awarded a Commendation from the Foreign Ministry of Japan and was inducted into the Order of the Rising Sun, the highest civilian honor granted to foreigners by the Japanese government.

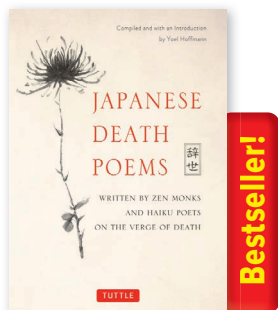

No Longer Human

No Longer Human is the story of Yozo Oba who, from an early age, finds it impossible to form meaningful relationships with family or friends. As a child he copes by acting the fool—mocking himself while entertaining others. As an adult he turns to alcohol, sex and drugs, which lead to his eventual self-destruction.

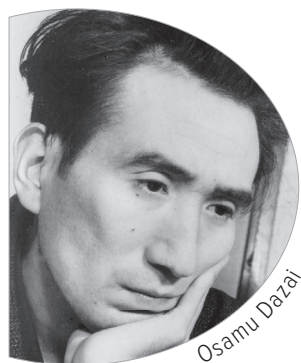
In this novel, based closely on his own life, Dazai skillfully leads the reader to sympathize deeply with Oba. Although the book was published in 1948, the timeless and universal themes of social alienation, failure, and one man’s inner

torture at his inability to feel like a normal human still resonate with young people everywhere, making this an enduring international classic.

After Sōseki Natsume, Osamu Dazai is Japan’s most popular writer. Dazai is enjoying a surge in interest among young people today thanks to the success of the manga, anime and film series *Bungo Stray Dogs*, whose protagonist, a detective named Osamu Dazai, is based on the real-life author.

Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) first attracted attention in 1933 when magazines began to publish his work. Between 1930 and 1937, he made three suicide attempts, a subject he deals with in many of his short stories. Despite his troubled life and rebellious spirit, Dazai wrote in a simple and colloquial style, conveying his own experiences. Dazai’s life ended early in a double suicide with a married lover.

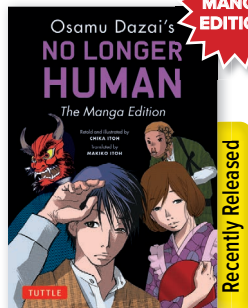
Juliet Winters Carpenter is an award-winning American translator of modern Japanese fiction who studied at the University of Michigan and the Inter-University Center for Japanese Language Studies in Tokyo. After completing her studies, she returned to Japan where she became involved in translation and teaching. She is professor emerita at Doshisha Women’s College of Liberal Arts in Kyoto and has received numerous awards for her translation work including the William F. Sibley Memorial Award for Japanese Translation for her rendering of Mizumura Minae’s *An I-Novel* and the Lindsey and Masao Miyoshi Translation Prize for a lifetime of achievement as a translator of modern Japanese literature.

Hōjōki is an introspective poem written in the 13th century by the enigmatic Japanese writer Kamo no Chōmei, who as a young man served as official court poet in the capital, but later in life became a recluse.

Composed in a time of devastating fires, floods, earthquakes and famines, Chōmei’s verses reflect on the impermanence of things, expressing life’s mysteries and

the profound wisdom to be found in nature.

Chōmei paints a vivid picture of the chaos and suffering of the human condition. But amidst all this, he discovers an oasis of calm in a simple mountain hut, where he contemplates the virtues of nature and the wabi sabi beauty of imperfection in all things.

This new translation by Matthew Stavros, presented alongside the original Japanese, perfectly captures the profound serenity of Chōmei’s text. His poignant verses serve as timely reminders that true contentment can be found in embracing fleeting moments and in seeking solace in nature’s beauty.

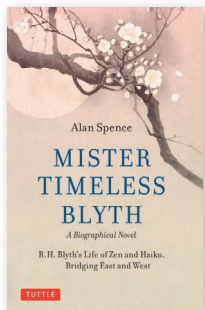
Kamo no Chōmei was a Japanese poet, musician and essayist who died in 1216. While in his fifties, he became a recluse, moving to Mount Hiei outside Kyoto then to Hino, where he built a tiny hut and spent the rest of his life writing and contemplating.

Matthew Stavros holds a PhD from Princeton University and is senior lecturer in Japanese and Asian Studies at the University of Sydney and former director of the Kyoto Consortium for Japanese Studies. He is the author of *Kyoto: An Urban History of Japan’s Premodern Capital* and *In Praise of Solitude: Two Japanese Classics on Reclusion*.

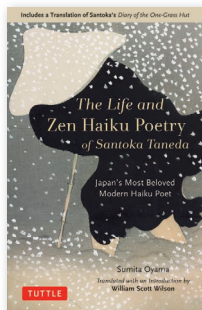

The Water Margin is an epic tale set in 12th century Imperial China, one of the earliest and greatest masterpieces of Chinese fiction. This fascinating book provides an unvarnished look at the post-war history of Japan and offers cautionary tales about how welcoming Japan really is towards outsiders. It is based on original research and reporting by the author, a 60-year resident of Tokyo.

Robert Whiting is the author of *You Gotta Have Wa*, named as one of Esquire's Best Baseball Books Ever Written and *Tokyo Underworld*. He has lived in Japan since 1962 and is regarded as one of the foremost experts on the country. The California native has written for many publications in his long career, including *The New York Times*, *The Smithsonian*, *Sports Illustrated*, *Newsweek*, *Time*, and *U.S. News and World Report*. His first book, *The Chrysanthemum and the Bat*, was named Time's Sports Book of the Year in 1977. He is also a recipient of the 2023 Henry Chadwick Award, which honors those who research and write about baseball.

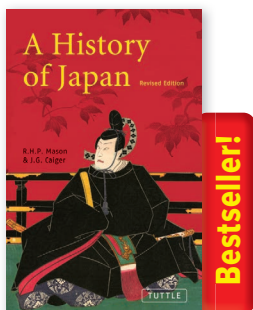

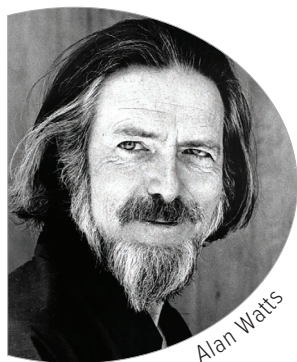
In this book, Watts explores all aspects of Buddhism—from its roots in ancient India to the explosion of interest in Zen and

- **The Religion of No-Religion**—How Buddhism eschews any particular dogma and instead acts as a guide to understanding oneself
- **Buddhism as Dialogue**—How Zen teaches us that we are one with the world and so as we learn to navigate the world, we must also learn about ourselves

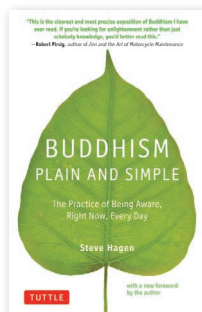
Watts traces the early beginnings of Buddhism, outlines the differences between Buddhism and other religions, and reviews the *Four Noble Truths* and *The Eightfold Path*. *Buddhism: The Religion of No-Religion* is a valuable reminder of the peace to be found by looking inward.

Alan Watts was a former Episcopal priest, born in London in 1915. He came to the U.S. in the 1930s, where he would become a scholar of Eastern religions. He moved to San Francisco in 1951 where he began teaching Buddhist studies, and in 1956 began his popular radio show, *Way Beyond the West*. By the early 1960s, Alan’s radio talks aired nationally and the counterculture movement adopted him as a spiritual spokesperson. He went on to write more than twenty other books. He died in 1973.



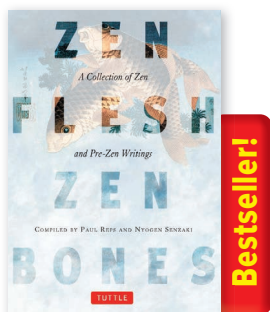

Each chapter features a number of short, thought-provoking essays providing fresh perspectives on familiar problems that can change your life!

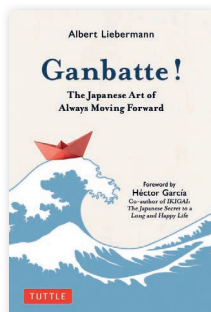

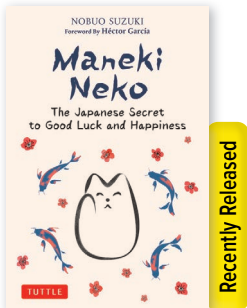
William Woodard directed the research unit of the Religious and Cultural Resources Division, Civil Information & Education Section, SCAP from 1946 to 1952.

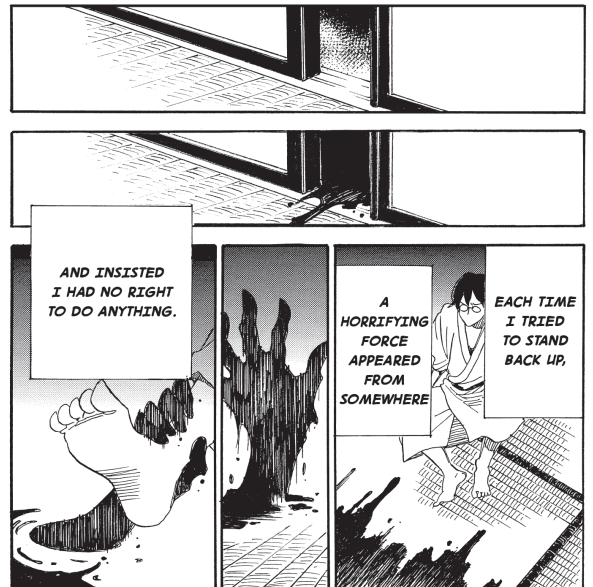
Set in the early 20th century, *Kokoro* opens with a chance encounter on a beach near Tokyo that irrevocably links a young student to a man he simply calls Sensei ("Teacher"). Intrigued by Sensei's aloofness, the student calls upon him with increasing frequency. Eventually, Sensei and his beautiful wife open their home and their lives to him. Only later does the student learn the devastating secret that has haunted Sensei since his youth.

Kokoro has sold millions of copies in Japan, where it is taught in schools and is a perennial favorite. Its lucid prose and universal themes of friendship, betrayal and the struggle for meaning in a changing world have made it popular internationally as well. This English-language manga version will make the book accessible to a new generation of foreign readers.

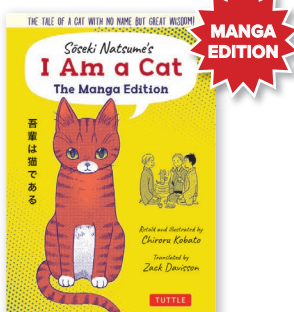

Sōseki Natsume was born in Tokyo in 1867. He taught English in a small town before studying for three years in England. Returning to teach at Tokyo University, he began his writing career soon after. He is the most popular novelist in Japan and the only Japanese author always referred to by his first name (Sōseki).

Nagi Yoshizaki is a Japanese manga artist who has illustrated many graphic novels in his native Japan. The works he is best known for include *Atashi, Hitori...*, *Zettai Triangle Love* and *For You, My Beloved*.

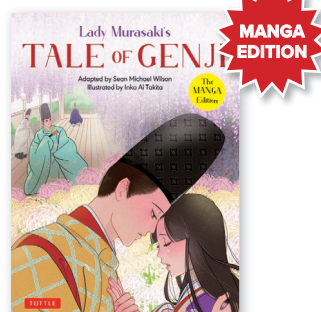

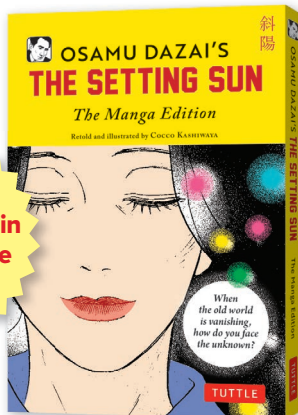

The works of Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) have seen a huge surge in popularity recently among young people worldwide thanks to the success of the manga and anime series *Bungo Stray Dogs*, whose protagonist is a detective called Osamu Dazai, closely based on the real-life author. Fans of the manga have been turning to the writings of the real Dazai, whose themes of alienation from society and the contradictions between outer appearances and inner self still resonate today.

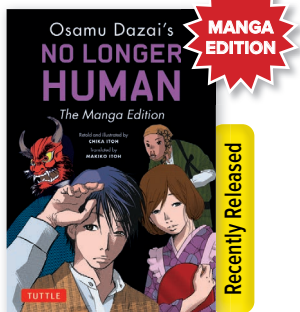


This is the first manga version of Dazai’s classic novel *The Setting Sun*, considered by many to be his greatest masterpiece. Set in the aftermath of World War II, it is the story of Kazuko—a strong-willed woman from an aristocratic family that has fallen into poverty. The book follows her journey as she and her family struggle to survive and adapt to the harsh new conditions. In addition to moving from the city to the countryside, where she is forced to work in the fields, she has to deal with a difficult divorce, the birth of a stillborn child and the return of her drug-addicted brother from the war.

Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) studied French literature at the University of Tokyo, eventually leaving without a degree. He first attracted attention in 1933 when magazines began to publish his work. Between 1930 and 1937, he made three suicide attempts, a subject he deals with in many of his short stories. Despite his troubled life and rebellious spirit, Dazai wrote in a simple and colloquial style, conveying his own experiences. Dazai’s life ended early in a double suicide with a married lover.

Cocco Kashiwaya, born in 1970, is a Tokyo-based manga artist. In 2010, her manga series *Rikon Dokyo* was made into a national TV drama in Japan.

He has received awards from the International Ukiyo-e Society and the International Fine Print Dealers Association.

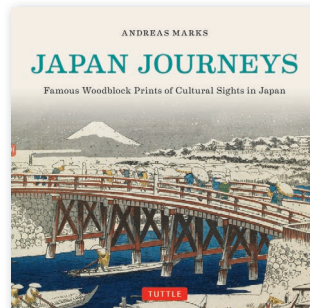

Dog Ear Designs

If there's anything we love as much as cats, it's dogs. They come in so many shapes and sizes, irresistible fodder for any furry or kemonomimi artist. Here are just a few ideas for canine-inspired character creations. Find your own direction and run with it!

Dachshund

The image of a treasure hunter comes to mind, searching for riches. The goggles, patch and cape, along with the jacket and fringed shorts, add to the character, highlighting her boundless energy and curious nature.

Since this dog has a long, slender form, the silhouette around the neck is emphasized.

A long snout helps show movement. It also creates a wider silhouette.

What kind of dog is this? Its name comes from the German words "dachs," meaning hedgehog, and "hund," meaning dog. The long torso and short legs, which are its most distinctive features, made this breed an effective hunting dog. With long muzzles and drooping ears, there are three types of body hair: short, smooth haired, soft and long haired or long and wavy haired.

Drooping ears become part of the hairstyle.

Color Palette

A paw mark reinforces the furry kemonomimi feature.

Large work boots perfect for a treasure hunter's toils.

Border Collie

A shepherdess is the perfect persona for a shepherd-inspired character. The dog has fluffy ears and an upward-curving tail, so be sure to include these two features.

The shape of each ear can vary on each side.

The highlights contrast with the white fur stripes.

The fur around the snout suggests the shape of a border collie.

The rustic-style clothing and color scheme were inspired by a stronger sense of fantasy. The original embroidery on the skirt has been incorporated into the cape and sleeves.

Kemonomimi style hair.

Only one leg is given a black knee sock. The asymmetry of the design gives it a unique look.

What kind of dog is this? Collies were originally bred as sheepdogs in the Scotland. They're medium-sized dogs with large eyes and a sturdy build. They come in both short-haired and long-haired breeds and a variety of coat colors.

Woolly trim on the boots suggests the soft, long hair.

A shepherd's staff.

Color Palette

Shiba Inu

This classic Japanese breed has here been transformed into a young man in a student uniform from the Meiji/Taisho era. The character's palette is based on a black-haired Shiba Inu instead of a brownish red-haired one.

A mushroom cut captures the breed's dark coat.

All black would make the design heavy and monochromatic. Red and yellow are added to the cap to create contrast.

Small erect ears match the face.

Many modern student uniforms are said to have been based on those of the Imperial University, which was established in 1886.

A cape-like cloth creates a broadened silhouette.

A curly tail.

Color Palette

What kind of dog is this? A popular breed from Japan, it has small ears and a thick curly tail. They have short body hair, and their coat color varies widely. Originally bred as a hunting dog, they're prized pets for being smart and independent.

Golden Retriever

Here a golden retriever is transformed into an energetic boy who seems to get along with everyone. His casual street-style fashion adds to the image.

If the hair is too long, it'll obscure the eyes and face, so a short style works best.

The much-loved retriever family has almond-shaped eyes and drooping ears. The coat color is shiny gold or cream. The front of the body, the chest and abdomen, the backs of the legs and the tail are covered with long, fluffy hair.

Keep the clothes simple to show off the bushy, droopy ears.

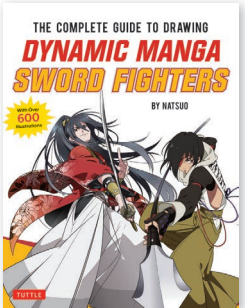

At the Controls

Without some way to steer an airplane in flight, it would be practically useless. Once off the ground, there's nothing to push against but air. But that's quite enough! Here's how real planes do it.

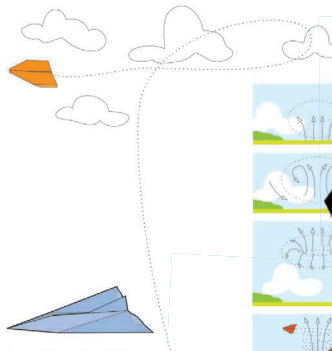
The rudder controls the direction of flight. It can be moved left or right to push the tail in the opposite direction. When the rudder (or any other control surface) is moved, the airplane pivots around its center of gravity. The motion caused by the rudder is called yaw.

The hinged portions at the back of the horizontal stabilizers are called elevators, and as you would expect, they make the plane go up or down. Both elevators move together (though in some jets or delta planes they can move separately to function as ailerons as well). When they are turned down, they create more lift at the tail and pivot the nose of the plane down. When they are turned up, the tail goes down, the nose goes up, and the plane climbs. This motion is called pitch.

The rudder alone is not enough to make turns. Ailerons, the little hinged parts on the wingtips, are used to make the plane bank when turning. The two ailerons move in opposite directions, one up and the other down. The down aileron makes more lift on that wing, and banks it up; the up aileron pushes its wing down. Banking motions are called roll.

All of these surfaces can be used at the same time to create delicate and precise maneuvers. For example, ailerons and rudder can be used together to make smooth, banking turns, but unless elevator is added, the plane will sink as it turns.

Paper airplanes often don't have separate tails or fins like real planes, so there are no ailerons or rudders to use. Instead, you have to control the plane with just the back of the wings. But that's not a big problem. Bend both sides up or down to control pitch, and one side more than the other to control roll and yaw. Easy, once you know how it works!

When your plane circles inside one that rises faster than the plane sinks, it will climb with the air, like an eagle or sailplane.

Voyager

Paper is easy to fold. It holds creases fairly well, but after a while it starts to relax and unfold again. Paper airplanes fly fine when they are fresh and crisp, but as the paper begins to relax, they become puffy and loose. One way to stop this is to use a lock on the nose to hold everything together. For this plane, I have borrowed world record holder Takuo Toda's excellent nose lock mechanism. It might seem tricky to fold at first, but it soon becomes familiar and easy to do, and the difference in performance is worth it!



5 Fold and unfold the nose on lines 4 and 5. Fold 4 starts where the thickness of the paper changes.

6 Spread the nose on the creases, squash it flat, fold the loose tip down on line 6, and push the bottom half around to the back.

1 Start with the paper exactly as shown. Fold up on line 1. The diagram shows how to find where to fold.

2 Fold the corners on the 2 lines to the point shown.

7 Fold the wings on the 7 lines. The edge of the wing should touch the top of the centerline.

8 Open out the wings, and you're done!

3 Fold the new corners to the center on the 3 lines.

4 Mountain fold the plane in half.

Nukazuke Pickling Bed Ingredients

Stir Fried Summer Vegetables and Pork with Soybean Miso

Sour old pickled vegetables go so well with rich soybean miso. The punchy spicy and sour taste is so appetizing.

SERVES 2

- 1 small old pickled eggplant
- 1 old pickled red bell pepper
- 1 old pickled yellow bell pepper
- About 3½ oz (100 g) thinly sliced pork belly
- 1 garlic clove

A Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon soybean miso (or other miso)
- ½ tablespoon sake
- 1 tablespoon mirin
- ½ teaspoon doubanjiang (Chinese spicy bean paste, available at Asian grocery stores)
- Sesame oil

Additional sesame oil for cooking

1. Rinse the pickling bed of the old eggplant and bell pepper pickles and drain. Cut into bite-sized pieces. Finely mince the garlic.
2. Add some sesame oil to a frying pan over medium-low heat and stir fry the garlic and pork.
3. When the pork is cooked through, add the pickles from Step 1 and stir fry.
4. Add the A ingredients and mix quickly.

Stir Fried Summer Vegetables and Pork with Soybean Miso

Fat Sushi Roll

Well-seasoned old nukazuke pickled vegetables are perfect for sushi. Since there is no need to pre-cook them, the ingredients used to fill the sushi roll can be used right out of the pickling bed.

SERVES 2

- 2 pieces ½ x 8 inch (7 mm x 20 cm) old pickled carrot
- 2 pieces ½ x 8 inch (7 mm x 20 cm) old pickled burdock root
- 2 pieces ½ x 8 inch (7 mm x 20 cm) old pickled cucumber
- 3½ oz (100 g) old pickled tuna

About 10 ½ oz (300 g) sushi rice
 2 sheets nori seaweed

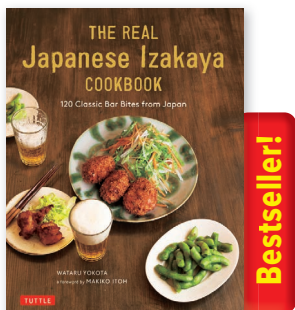
1. Rinse the pickling bed of the old pickles and drain. Cut the ingredients to the same length as the nori seaweed.
2. Spread the sushi rice on the nori seaweed, place the Step 1 fillings in the center and roll. (If the vegetables are too short, you can combine several pieces.) Moisten a sharp knife with a wet kitchen cloth, and cut the sushi roll into slices of your chosen size.

Creating Jin and Shari

"Jin" means that the branch appears to be in a dead state. "Shari" refers to the fact that the trunk appears to be dead. Both of these techniques are used to create the look of an old tree enduring the rigors of nature by shaving the branches and trunk, and are a major highlight of pine and oak bonsai, such as the Shouku and Morimatsu bonsai.

Because ginning and shari making can be very taxing on the trees, late February–early March, when the cold weather slackens a bit, is the best time to do it. Working at the time of the "Mere Old Man" will not only reduce the burden, but will also speed up the healing of the damaged area.

Once the tips are understood, even beginners can do it, but if new shoots begin to appear even in early March, the work must be forsaken.

Creating jin (late February)



1

Zing the top of the trunk. After dropping the branches and leaves, crush the top by pushing them with a barely-chance wire.



2

The bark of a living trunk or branch is easy to peel. Remove the bark by jacking it up and pulling it down from the top.

Creating shari (late February)



1

Make the shari with the flow from the top jin. A triangular carving knife is useful for shaving the bark of the trunk.

A certain amount of bark is left behind, as it will weather if all of it is removed. Again, be aware of the flow from the jin to the shari.

Use a small nailfile or similar tool to peel off areas where an engraver's blade will not penetrate.

After making the jin and shari, apply lime sulfur compound diluted with water with a brush. In addition to preventing moldy parts from rotting, the coated areas will become pure white after drying, making the jin and shari stand out.
