"Are you hungry?"

Nĭ lèi bu lèi?

"Are you tired?"

Nǐ máng bu máng?

"Are you busy?"

Nǐ kùn bu kùn?

"Are you drowsy?"

Nǐ lĕng bu lĕng?

"Are you cold?"

Nǐ tóu téng bu téng?

"Does your head hurt?"

Nǐ xiăng bù xiăng tù?

"Do you feel like throwing up?"

Nĭ yŏu méiyou fāshāo?

"Do you have a fever?"

Wŏ yŏu yìdiănr è.

"I'm a little hungry."

Wŏ yŏu yìdiănr lèi.

"I'm a bit tired."

Wŏ yŏu yìdiănr máng.

"I'm a little busy."

Wŏ yŏu yìdiănr kùn.

"I'm a little drowsy."
