1. Transform the bisyllabic stative verbs in the sentences you hear to the reduplicated forms with **-de**. For example, **gāoxìng** “be happy” would become **gāogāoxìngxìngde** “very happily.”

Zhù nǐ jiànkāng.

“I wish you that you’re healthy.”

Tā zhèige rén hěn ānjìng.

“He’s very quiet.”

Màikè xiězi xiěde hěn qīngchū.

“Michael writes clearly.”

Dàwèide sùshè tǐng gānjìngde.

“David’s dorm is quite clean.”

Xiǎomíng zǒngshì hěn gāoxìng.

“Xiaoming is always happy.”

Jīntiānde tiānqì bù lěng yě bú rè, hěn shūfu.

“Today’s weather is neither cold nor hot,
very comfortable.”

Zhù nǐ jiànjiānkāngkāngde.

“I wish you that you’re all healthy and everything.”

Tā zhèige rén ān’ānjìngjìngde.

“He’s all quiet and everything.”

Dàwèide sùshè gān’gānjìngjìngde.

“David’s dorm is nice and clean.”

Xiǎomíng zǒngshì gāogāoxìngxìngde.

“Xiaoming is always very happy and everything.”
