

Unit 24, Part 4: Transformation and Response Drills

1. You're interested in possibly riding in a friend's car, but she sets all kinds of what you consider to be unreasonable conditions. Therefore, when you hear her state the condition, respond that you'd rather not go in her car than do what she demands. In your responses, use the pattern **nìngyuàn...yě bú yào....**

Nǐ rúguǒ xiǎng zuò wǒde chē, jiù děi zǎoshang wǔdiǎn chūmén.

"If you want to go in my car, then you have to leave home at 5:00 in the morning."

Nǐ rúguǒ xiǎng zuò wǒde chē, jiù děi ān'anjìngjìngde zuòzai hòumian.

"If you want to go in my car, then you have to very quietly sit in the back."

Nǐ rúguǒ xiǎng zuò wǒde chē, jiù děi bāng wǒ kàn dìtú.

"If you want to go in my car, then you have to help me read the maps."

Nǐ rúguǒ xiǎng zuò wǒde chē, jiù děi zhàogu wǒde háizi.

"If you want to go in my car, then you have to take care of my kid."

Nǐ rúguǒ xiǎng zuò wǒde chē, jiù děi tì wǒ fù yóu qián.

"If you want to go in my car, then you have to pay the gas money for me."

Wǒ nìngyuàn bú zuò nǐde chē, yě bú yào zǎoshang wǔdiǎn chūmén.

"I'd rather not go in your car than leave home at 5:00 in the morning."

Wǒ nìngyuàn bú zuò nǐde chē, yě bú yào ān'anjìngjìngde zuòzai hòumian.

"I'd rather not go in your car than very quietly sit in the back."

Wǒ nìngyuàn bú zuò nǐde chē, yě bú yào bāng nǐ kàn dìtú.

"I'd rather not go in your car than help you read the maps."
