## Requesting something

There are many ways to make a request in Japanese, with different politeness levels and shades of formality. It is challenging for foreign learners to select the right one for different contexts. Some of the most commonly used forms are listed below. The top two are the most common, and the rest are ordered in order of formality, from most formal to least formal.

1. ください	kudasai	please give (it) to me
2. おねがいします	onegai shimasu	I humbly request (it)
3. くださいませんか	kudasaimasen ka	could you please give (it) to me?
4. いただけませんか	itadakemasen ka	could I have (it)please?
5. いただいていいですか	itadaite ī desu ka	would it be okay if I have (it)?
6. いただきたいんですけど	itadakitai n desu kedo	I'd like to have (it) but

7. もらえませんか

8. もらっていいですか

9. もらいたいんですけど

10. くれませんか

11. くれる?
