
A superb example of origami geometry and human design skills. The final locking move is a little tricky, but just be gentle with the paper, and you'll get it.













1 With the unpatterned side facing up, fold in half edge to edge and unfold.



**2** Fold from the bottom right corner so the lower left corner touches the vertical crease.



**3** The result, forming a 60 degree angle. Unfold the flap.









4 Fold so the lower-left edge lies along the crease you made in step 2.




**5** Fold so the circled points meet, crease and unfold.




6 Fold so the lower edge lies along the crease you made in step 5.




7 The result. Turn the paper over.




**8** Fold edge to edge, crease, unfold and turn back over. (The crease will not meet the corner.)




**7** Fold the left edge to the inner shaded edge, crease and unfold.



**10** Fold so the outer end of the crease meets the circled point.



11 Make the two valley folds, flattening the paper to form the mountain fold.



**12** Fold so the circled points meet.





