Hōichi Kurisu, Takeo Uesugi, David Slawson, Shin Abe and Marc Keane have each interpreted the style and meaning of the Japanese garden in new ways. Several recent gardens by each designer are featured in this book through detailed descriptions and sumptuous color photos. Included are essays on the designers and mini-essays by them about gardens in Japan which have inspired their work, as well as commentaries by patrons and visitors to their gardens.

Visionary Landscapes focuses on recently-created gardens to suggest how the art form is evolving and to understand how Japanese garden design principles are being adapted today to suit the needs and ways of people living outside Japan. In addition to public and commercial gardens that can be easily accessed, this book presents private gardens that are usually never seen by the public and are published here for the first time.

Kendall H. Brown is Professor of Asian Art History at California State University Long Beach. Dr. Brown is a leading figure in the study of Japanese gardens in North America and the author of *Japanese-Style Gardens of the Pacific West Coast* and *Quiet Beauty: The Japanese Gardens of North America*.

Glitter polish and glitter itself is really hard to remove with the method used for regular polish. To simplify the task and avoid frustration, use a different procedure, as illustrated below:

materials needed

- ALUMINUM FOIL
- COTTON PADS
- HAIR POLISH REMOVER
- SCISSORS

Before proceeding to remove glitter polish, cut a cotton pad in four, and wrap aluminum foil into 4 x 4 inch (10 x 10 cm) steps.

1 Wrap the nail along with the pad, covering both in aluminum foil.

2 Leave for several minutes.

3 Take a cotton pad soaked in nail polish and place it on the glitter polish.

4 Remove the foil with downward circular movements; repeat the procedure on every nail.

5 After removing the nail polish, take another cotton pad soaked in polish remover and lightly wipe the nails again to remove any final residue of color. Wash and dry hands thoroughly before applying a top coat.

Japan has many options for food and for every budget, especially in bigger cities like Tokyo and Osaka. With the great competition of the various restaurants, the prices are very reasonable. If you would like to go to a fancier place, a reservation is a good idea. With so many restaurants in Tokyo, it can be hard to decide where to eat. The Internet is a great resource for finding a place that is likely to be a good indication that it is a good place to try. Also, if you go to a bookstore in Japan, you will often find city guide magazines mostly in Japanese, but some in English that have plenty of great recommendations.







Businesses that people are not using credit cards, please credit systems like Apple Pay and Square Reader until purchasing movie tickets. To withdraw money, you can go to a post office, 7-Eleven, Lawson, or FamilyMart. Please note that some of these places, they don't accept your place of birth or your residence or money have automatic alert if cards are used overseas.

Companies can easily be transferred at the branch at your local bank. Please note that transfer checks have been very hard to get in to the United States and are often hard to use overseas. "The Floating World"—a catchphrase that defined the pleasure quarters of Edo-period Japan (1615–1868) and conveyed a fantasy realm where men were led to believe they could drift aimlessly in the pursue of pleasure. Brothels were a prominent feature, but other entertainments, such as theater, music and wrestling were also offered. Pursuit of such pleasures prompted a revolution in fashion, literature and the visual arts, as the pleasure district was marketed not just through the offer of sex but rather through the elaboration of the seductive image of a sophisticated demi-monde that beckoned visitors.

Seduction shows how images of courtesans were constructed as objects of desire, and it considers how the artistic version aligned with, or departed from, the reality of women's lives. It traces the ways that art was used to transport viewers to a constructed realm of sensory delights to stimulate desires and gratify fantasies of carefree pleasure. Editor Laura W. Allen offers an overview of the seductive spell cast by the floating world and provides helpful entries on each of the featured objects. Essays by Melinda Takeuchi, Eric C. Rath and Julia Meech introduce the floating world, consider the role of food in the pleasure quarter and explore the feminine gaze in the Japanese print. The result is a fascinating study of the way that visual objects were used to convey insider knowledge about the latest fashions in clothing, hairstyles, accessories and even games. Armed with such knowledge, a visitor to the pleasure quarters would be prepared for the pursuit of love and other objects of desire.


