These delicate herb-filled rolls are so delicious and healthy. They're great to have at parties because your friends can get into the act and make their own rolls (omit the shrimp for vegetarians). They may be called Summer Rolls but you'll want to enjoy them all year round. In Korea, life milestones have traditionally been celebrated with festivals and feasts. Such celebrations helped to define and honor an individual's identity. Based on a 2009 exhibition at the National Museum of Korea, the exhibition at the Asian Art Museum that *In Grand Style* documents incorporates new findings and researches. Qian Ning graduated from the people's University of China with his B.A. and M.A. degrees on literature. He worked as a reporter for the *People's Daily* from 1986 to 1989 and was a Michigan Journalism Fellow (the University of Michigan) in 1989–1990. His most famous book is *Chinese Students Encounter America*, a bestseller in China.


